### Cleaning

Cleaning and storing your One Power Readers is very simple.

- Rinse the One Power Readers with tap water. This will help remove any dust or dirt that has settled on them.
- 2. Use a microfiber or cotton cleaning cloth to gently wipe the lens dry. It is best to wipe from one side using a circular motion.
- 3. You should also wipe the nose pad and the hinges to remove any oil that may have gotten on them.

### Storage

Follow these tips and tricks for storing and caring for your One Power Readers. These tips can help you keep your One Power Readers looking and feeling like new year after year.

- When you are wearing your reading glasses, it can be a good idea to attach them to a chain or a lanyard that hangs around your neck. This can help keep them handy and always within reach. It also can help you avoid misplacing or losing them.
- Take your One Power Readers off with two hands. Put one hand on each end of the frame and pull gently. This helps prevent the frames from stretching and the screws from becoming loose.
- 3. Try not to wear your reading glasses on top of your head because it can distort the shape of your glasses.
- 4. When not wearing your glasses, it is a good idea to return them to the microfiber storage case or a solid protective glasses case.

- 5. When putting your One Power Readers down, always rest them on a flat surface and place them with the frames upside down.
- 6. Avoid leaving your One Power Readers on the dashboard or seat of your car. The direct intense heat can distort their shape.
- 7. Try to avoid letting perspiration or hair spray stay on the lenses for extended periods of time. If you are sweating or have just sprayed your hair, it is a good idea to wipe off your lenses.
