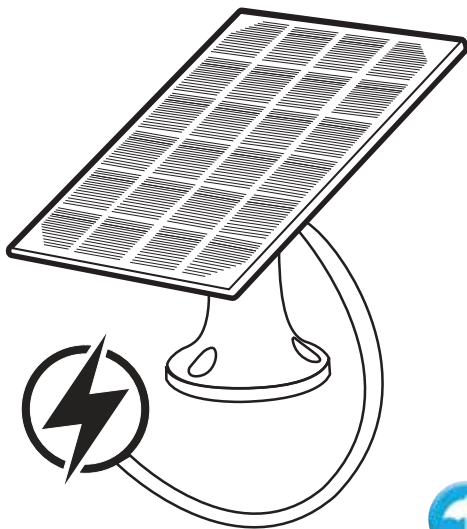


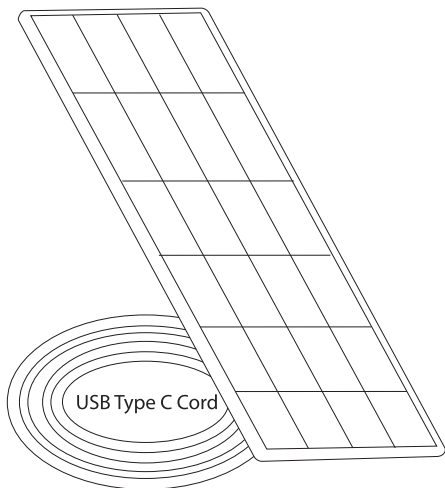

Setting Up Your Solar Panel

Included Parts for your Solar Panel



NOTE: To ensure proper use of your Solar Panel please follow the instructions detailed in this set-up guide.

Setting Up Your Solar Panel

Step 1: Choose a suitable spot near the outside for your Solar Panel installation

1. Ensure the Solar Panel is positioned in a location with steady sunlight year-round. A few hours of direct sunlight daily will suffice to maintain your device's power supply.

Note: the solar panel's energy output may vary due to factors like weather, seasons, and geographic location.

Setting Up Your Solar Panel

Step 2: Install the Solar Panel at the designated mounting location

1. Secure the base to the mounting location by utilizing the provided screws.

If the installation surface is soft or unstable, start by drilling a hole in the wall using a drill bit, then insert the anchor nail into the hole, and fasten the base with screws.

Setting Up Your Solar Panel

Step 2: Install the Solar Panel at the designated mounting location

2. Attach the universal joint to the back of the Solar Panel and securely tighten using the socket nut.
3. Screw the Locking Screw Cap into the base, ensuring that the Universal Joint is angled upward.

Setting Up Your Solar Panel

Step 2: Install the Solar Panel at the designated mounting location.

4. To adjust the solar panel horizontally, first, loosen the Locking Screw Cap. Next, rotate the Sleeve Rod to the desired position. Finally, tighten the Locking Screw Cap once the panel is correctly aligned.
5. The angle of the solar panel can be adjusted up and down by up to 90 degrees.

Tip: After completing the installation, ensure all locking mechanisms are tightly secured.

Setting Up Your Solar Panel

Step 3: Position your Solar Panel to get the most direct sunlight

1. Locate the spot receiving the maximum direct sunlight daily.
2. Tilt the Solar Panel upwards at a 30° angle.
3. Face it south in the northern hemisphere and north in the southern hemisphere.

Step 4: Connect your Solar Panel to any Outside devices

1. Connect your Outside device using the cable linked to your Solar Panel.

Tip: Regularly wipe the Solar Panel's surface with a soft, damp cloth to remove dust and debris.
